

Estimated Poverty Rates by Option

The estimated poverty rates for the following schools were calculated using the 2016-2017 free or reduced lunch data as reported to the Virginia Department of Education National School Lunch Program. For the baseline and each option, the percentage of middle school students receiving free or reduced lunch meals living in each middle school boundary were calculated. Students who attend specific programs [Middle Year IB and Exceptional Education Zone Programs] outside of their zoned middle school were included in the data for the school they are currently attending. These students stayed consistent in each option calculation.
