SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Brookland is located in the middle of Henrico County. It was built in 1958 and renovated in 2012. Situated on 33 acres, there are 13 buildings including seven classroom buildings, a gym and activities building, a library, three cafeterias, and an administration building.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Brookland Middle School operates on a modified block schedule with a total of eight classes. On Mondays, students report to every class. On Tuesday through Friday, students have four 90-minute classes per day. Tuesdays and Thursdays are referred to as Day 1. Wednesdays and Fridays are referred to as Day 2. The day begins at 8:35 am and ends at 3:15 pm. Numerous instructional levels are offered in each academic course. Instructional levels include, but are not limited to Exceptional Education, Gifted and Talented, and English as a Second Language. We have the largest ELL population in Henrico County. Students in 7th and 8th grades may begin taking courses for high school credit.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2016-2017 school year, there are 80 faculty and staff serving approximately 1020 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, associate principal, assistant principal, and three administrative aides. The School Counseling department has four full-time school counselors and a registrar.

There are two types of honor roll reports: All A, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and Honor Roll, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses take. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, S or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.
