SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Hungary Creek Middle School opened on September 7, 2004 and currently has over 1,080 students. Located in Glen Allen, our school operates with one of the most up-to-date technology systems available. A state-of-the-art media retrieval system allows teachers to access video and DVD technology in their classrooms via an overhead beam system.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Block scheduling allows teachers to provide in-depth coverage of content during classes that meet every other day for 90 minutes, with a day 1 / day 2 schedule. The staff uses interactive teaching techniques to challenge and engage our students with the addition of a maker hub. It is our mission to identify the needs of the students and facilitate their learning by making connections between subject areas, maintaining discipline, and communicating effectively with parents and the community to empower students to become self-disciplined, responsible citizens in a global technological society. Hungary Creek is fully accredited based on 2016-2017 SOL results.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2017-18 school year, there are over 100 faculty and staff serving approximately 1,080 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, associate principal, 2 assistant principals, six administrative aides as well as a part-time dean of student services. The School Counseling department has three full-time school counselors, one part-time counselor and a registrar.

Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, S, or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.
