2016-2017 SCHOOL PROFILE

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

We are located in the north central portion of Henrico County. Our school was built in 1951 on 20 acres and was renovated from 2000 through the summer of 2002.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Moody Middle School students enroll in one of three academic programs. A large number of students are enrolled in the zone middle school program and they are given an opportunity to take advanced classes if appropriate. In addition to the zone program a small number of students are enrolled in exceptional education classes. These classes have a small pupil to teacher ratio in order to assist those students with specific emotional or learning disabilities.

Moody Middle School also houses the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme. Students throughout the county apply to this program in the fall of their 5th or 6th grade year. This is a rigorous program, and students are subject to the State of Virginia educational guidelines as well as those set forth by the International Baccalaureate Organization. At present, there are 670 students enrolled in this program in grades 6-8.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2016-2017 school year, there are 63 teachers (2 PT) serving 1019 students. The administration consists of the principal, an associate principal, and an assistant principal. The School Counseling Department has one director, two full-time counselors, and a part-time counselor.

There are two types of honor roll reports: All A, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and Honor Roll, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, S, or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Courses such as S.O.L. Enrichment, 25 middle school courses and APP are not figured into any honor roll calculation. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.

FEEDER PATTERN:
