2016-2017 SCHOOL PROFILE

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Tuckahoe Middle School is a Blue Ribbon School built in 1958. The 23.5 acre campus style school is in the near west end of Henrico County next to Ridge ES and up the street from Freeman High School. Our diverse population and large geographical boundary make us a unique school with a variety of social and cultural backgrounds.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Tuckahoe operates on a modified block schedule with 8 periods. Mondays, students attend all 8 classes. Tuesdays and Thursdays, students are in periods one, two, three and four. Wednesdays and Fridays are five, six, seven and eight periods. Academic core enrichment offers content rich instruction that meets the needs of all our students. A variety of instructional levels are offered in our academic areas, including high school credit courses. Tuckahoe Middle is a recognized International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program School with 275 6th, 7th and 8th grade students.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2016-17 school year, there are 96 teachers serving 1075 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, an associate principal, two assistant principals and three administrative aides. The School Counseling department has three full-time school counselors and a registrar.

There are two types of honor roll reports: All A, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and Honor Roll, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, S, or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Courses such as S.O.L. Enrichment, and .25 middle school courses are not figured into any honor roll calculation. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.

FEEDER PATTERN:

Elementary – Students come to Tuckahoe from Crestview, Johnson, Maybeury, Ridge, Three Chopt, and Tuckahoe Elementary. Attendance zone determines which students from these schools attend Tuckahoe.
