

Henrico County Gifted Advisory Council

The Henrico County Gifted Advisory Council (GAC) is composed of parents, teachers, administrators, support staff, community representatives, and student representatives, dedicated to the study of issues and concerns of gifted education. The Council examines issues and advises the School Board, parents, and community on gifted education. **Meetings are held five times annually at 6 PM.** During these meetings and *other required* sub-committee meetings, written reports are prepared as input to the School Board to help strengthen gifted education in Henrico County.

The GAC includes two parent representatives from each magisterial district who serve three-year terms. Each year some representatives rotate off of the Council as their term ends and occasionally others may be unable to complete their term. If you are interested in being considered for a three-year term on the Henrico County Gifted Advisory Council, should a vacancy occur in your district, please fill out the lower portion of this sheet and return it to the Henrico County Gifted Education Office **by March 30, 2018.**
