<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify and demonstrate the difference between a singing and speaking voice. Imitate (echo) simple two-pitch patterns sung or played by the teacher. Participate in singing activities. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As a member of a group, demonstrate a steady beat by clapping, moving, playing, and body sounds. Imitate simple rhythm patterns. Match body movement to continuing rhythm patterns (walking, running, and galloping). Play simple rhythm instruments. Demonstrate that music can move fast or slow. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start to sing, play, or move at the appropriate time following the musical introduction of a familiar song.

Distinguish between vocal and instrumental music. Echo short phrases (charts and songs). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Glossary of musical terms and symbols follow
