2021-2022 SCHOOL PROFILE

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

The Henrico Virtual Academy was established in 2021 as Henrico County Public Schools' first K-12 virtual learning option that serves all districts of Henrico County. The HVA serves students and families from Henrico's 46 elementary schools, 12 middle schools, and 9 high schools.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

The Henrico Virtual Academy serves approximately 1400 students in grades K – 12. The HVA has a strong academic curriculum that aligns with the mission, vision, and strategic plan of HCPS including a number of supports to meet all intellectual, social, and emotional needs of our students. The students and staff of our school are equipped with state of the art technology, ensuring that our students are prepared for the digital age beyond graduation. The students of Henrico Virtual Academy have the opportunity to participate in clubs and sports through their zoned homeschools.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

The administrative team consists of the principal, an elementary associate principal, and a secondary administrative intern. The HVA is comprised of 61 elementary staff and 76 secondary staff. This includes 11 instructional assistants, 7 support staff, a librarian, school counseling team, coordinator for assessment and remediation, elementary and secondary ILC, elementary grade level and resource teachers, and secondary core content and elective teachers. The HVA's leadership extends to grade level and departmental leaders among grades K-12.

ATHLETIC TEAMS & CLUBS:

Students of the Henrico Virtual Academy have the opportunity to participate in clubs, organizations, and VHSL sports through their zoned homeschools. Student clubs are also held through Virtual Community by each HVA staff member that students can join based on individual interests. Additional committees currently offered by the HVA include
