

P10-03 Institutional Research

The Department of Assessment, Research, and Evaluation shall conduct institutional research as requested by the School Board and/or the Superintendent and his staff. Institutional Research is defined as analysis of organizational factors including such things as:

1. Trends in the operation of the school system from a historical perspective
2. Current status of the operation of the school system in relation to such things as student population, staffing, facilities, programs, costs, etc.
3. Projections of future needs in various aspects of the operation of the school system on the basis of trends and current status
4. Information about the school system which may be used as a basis for decisions by the School Board and the administration
5. Needs assessments
6. Follow-up studies of former students.
