

## P6-04-005 Demonstrations and Strikes

**After consultation with the principal or principal's designee, freedoms of expression, demonstrations, or strikes will not violate** ~~When freedom of expression includes violation of the rights of other students to an education. w~~**When such expression violates the Student Code of Conduct, those responsible will be subject to applicable consequences per the HCPS Student Code of Conduct,** ~~involves force, threat of force, actual law violation, or disrupts the school and/or its routine, those responsible will be suspended from school, ordered from the campus, and if necessary, further response will follow the Code of Virginia law enforcement agencies will may be called in to assist enforce the order. Thereafter, the case of the suspended students will be handled on an individual basis. as described in Policy 6-06-003, "Suspension or Expulsion."~~

**The Code of Student Conduct applies to all Henrico County Public School students and student groups. It is enforced when they are:**

- **On school property.**
- **Traveling to school or from school.**
- **Traveling to, at, and from bus stops.**
- **In School Board vehicles.**
- **In attendance at school or at any school-sponsored activity, including virtual classes and other school-sponsored online activities.**
