

P6-08-009 High School Equivalency Examinations Approved by the Board of Education

Persons who are no longer enrolled in public school and who meet the minimum requirements specified by the Virginia Department of Education are eligible to attempt a high school equivalency examination approved by the Board of Education. Students who have been enrolled in private schools, or who are home instructed, who meet these same requirements, are also eligible to attempt a high school equivalency examination approved by the Board of Education.

Under certain circumstances (outlined in regulation [6-08-009](#)), students under the age of 18 may be eligible to attempt a high school equivalency examination approved by the Board of Education.
