

P6-20-002 Fees

Students are not charged an instructional fee. However, small material fees for clubs or special classes, such as art ~~or physical education~~, may be charged. Material fees must be kept to a minimum and shall be used only to defray the costs of the goods or services which necessitated the collection. The amount of such fees shall be established by the School Board and parents shall be provided with information about the justification and use of the money collected.

A reduction or waiver of fees is available for students who are economically disadvantaged or whose families are undergoing economic hardship and are unable to pay.

No pupil's scholastic report card, diploma, or schedule shall be withheld for failure to pay any such fee or charge.
