## 2018-2019 SCHOOL PROFILE

### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Wilder Middle School is centrally located in the northwestern part of the county. The school was built in 1997.

### ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Wilder Middle School has 4 periods in a day. Double block math and English is available in all the grade levels for students that qualify.

**GYSA** – Gifted Young Scholars Academy is available for 6<sup>th</sup> grade this school year. This is an application based program where gifted scholars have an experience to be mainstreamed in electives and study with licensed teachers who understand the gifted scholar.

**CRC** - The College Readiness Center is available for grades 7-8. The application-based program implements an extended school year and dedicates itself to providing its students with college-ready skills aligned to college-ready standards.

### FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2018-2019 school year, there are 85 teachers serving 800 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, one associate principal, three assistant principals, and six administrative aides. The School Counseling Department has four full-time counselors and a registrar.

There are two types of honor roll reports: All A, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and Honor Roll, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, S, or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Courses such as Advisory and Innovative are not figured into an honor roll calculation. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.
